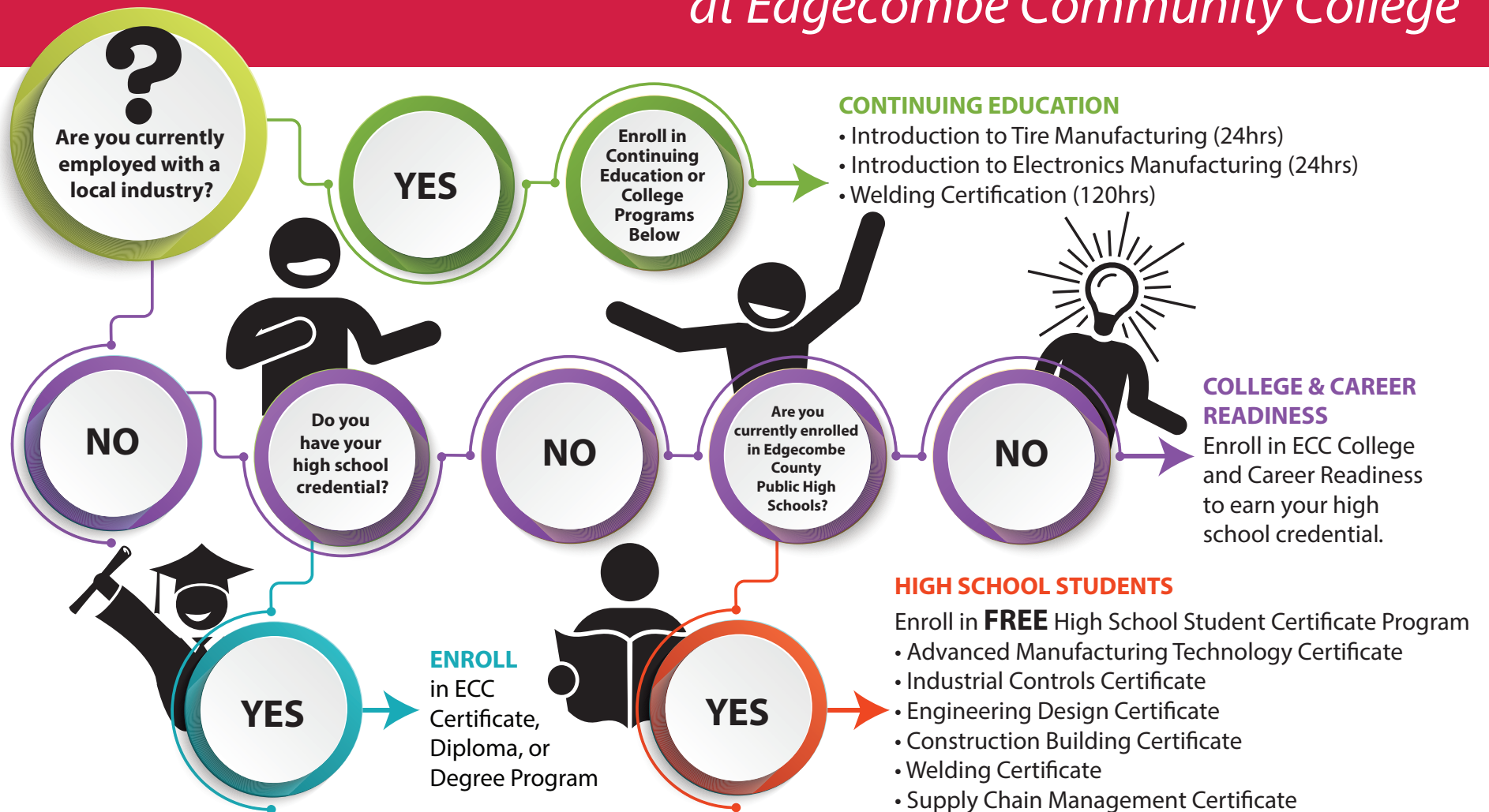

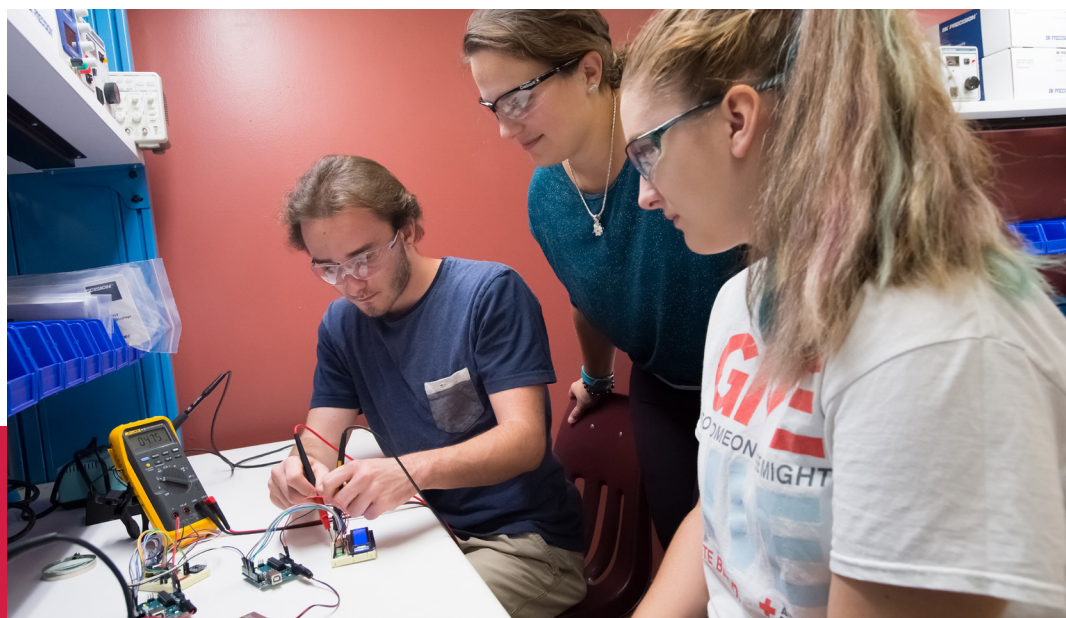
Companies in our region need skilled workers. Edgecombe Community College is the training solution.

Tuition & financial aid

Tuition at Edgecombe Community College remains affordable year after year.

- \$88 per semester hour in tuition and fees
- \$1,000 per semester (12 credit hours) for NC students
- 97% of students receive financial aid
- Average award amount is \$3,660
