## HITACHI Astemo

Upon successful completion of the 96-hour curriculum portion, STEPS4GROWTH participants will receive 80 hours of paid on-the-job training at Hitachi Astemo in Tarboro, NC, which will fulfill the requirements of the STEPS4GROWTH pre-apprenticeship program. Qualifying participants will be given the opportunity to continue job training with Hitachi Astemo through "Hitachi Astemo's SMT Internship Program." SMT interns will receive detailed and specialized job training to ensure they are fully capable of performing their job requirements. Interns that successfully complete "Hitachi Astemo's SMT Internship Program" will be offered full-time employment with a significant pay increase.

## Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Bronze level or above on the Workkeys assessment
- Resident of Edgecombe County
- 18 years or older
- Must be prepared to enter the workforce
- Must have transportation
- Must be able to commit to the schedule
